bridging the gap between food waste and food poverty locally

It was lovely to welcome so many people to our 1st meeting back after the summer break where we enjoyed an interesting talk from Claire, from Surplus to Supper as well as a couple of games of Bingo. For those of you that missed the evening, we thought it good for you to know a little about the thriving charity called Surplus to Supper based in Sunbury and the fantastic work they do within our local community. They collect fresh food that would otherwise have gone to waste and redistributed for free to support local foodbanks, schools, care homes, shelters, clubs, religious organisations and more. This is on a substantial scale with the charity currently collecting and donating on average 10 tonnes of food per week. They also asked if anyone has a few spare hours each month (or more) and are interested in helping out, they would love to hear from you...

SURPLUS SHOP

Open: Saturday and Sunday (11:30am - 1pm)

This is where they sell good quality food which would otherwise go to waste. The Surplus Shop is open for everyone and they welcome as many people as possible to pop along & make a mindful donation to buy their surplus food, so why not buy your food from here & donate to charity rather than Tesco's - all proceeds made from this go towards funding the running of their vans which enable the charity to do the great work they do.




